The Town Mayor, Cllr. Jackie Warner, welcomed Town Council members and public to an additional Meeting of Shipston on Stour Town Council.

- 1 Apologies for absence Cllrs. Henderson, White, Ivens and Murphy
- 2 Acceptance of Apologies Proposed Cllr. Scobie, seconded Cllr Rathkey unanimously agreed
- 3 <u>Declarations of Interest</u> none
  - New Planning applications
     Cllr Martin Ferrier was confirmed as chair of PWG, he chaired item 4.

15/01478/FUL – Land Off, Shoulderway Lane – 109 residential dwellings, 35% affordable provision and associated works, landscaping, open space and access.

Members of the public in attendance were offered the opportunity to speak on the Shoulderway Lane application – Mr Mike Taylor noted that SHARD will be submitting a considered view to SDC Planning; Mr Richard Adams raised concerns about access onto London Road from the proposed new estate; Mr Wardak noted potential drainage problems into Pig Brook, a survey of what is beneath the surface should be undertaken.

Cllrs noted various matters of concern, including: Not in keeping with needs of the town; inadequate infrastructure to support additional homes; not included in the NP; STC should be consistent in response allowing only modest developments up to 40 homes; flooding and drainage issues, especially into Pig Brook; concerns at speed of traffic from the south and lack of visual splay onto London Road;

Cllr Ferrier proposed objection for all of the above planning reasons, seconded Cllr Scobie – unanimously agreed

It was further noted that the ownership and management of the proposed open space and possible projects funded by CIL and/or S106 should be considered by SWG 15/01849/FUL – 4 Springfield Road – single storey rear extension and render to external walls Cllr Ferrier proposed no representation, seconded Cllr Rathkey – unanimously agreed 15/01255/FUL – Killarney Corner, Sheep Street – amendment Cllr Scobie proposed no representation, seconded Cllr Perry – unanimously agreed 15/01992/TEL28 – permitted dev. – electronic communication apparatus – information only
