Cllr Vial proposed that Cllr Murphy join the Sustainability Working Group, seconded Cllr Ferrier – unanimously agreed

Cllr Ivens, Chair of GPWG gave her report which was noted by STC

16 Communications Working Group

Cllr Vial introduced the report, following discussion Cllr Vial proposed that the CWG report be accepted in full and that software is purchased to enable easier updates for social media at a cost of £80, seconded Cllr. Cooper – **unanimously agreed**

17 Finance Group

Cllr. Cooper introduced his report, STC noted that progress had been made on the setting up of a 3 month trial for a monthly Sunday market.

18 Financial Matters

Cllr. Vial proposed that all invoices be paid, seconded Cllr. Ferrier – unanimously agreed

Correspondence – Number 49 a letter from Shipston Dental Practice was discussed, following discussion about the problems with A boards in the town centre, Cllr Vial proposed that STC do not agree to support the request to allow an A board outside the Dental Practice in Sheep Street, seconded Cllr Cooper – vote – 7 for, 1 abstention – motion carried
