#### **NEW PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

14/03469/FUL & 14/03470/LBC – Clerkenwell House, 12-14 High Street and 2-4 Market Place – Works to provide restaurant, food shop and letting bedrooms. The applicants gave an explanation of the plans for a new restaurant and letting rooms, along with refurbishment of the existing food shop, following questions from councillors, Cllr Vial proposed that STC support both applications for the following reasons: Improvement to street scene, economic development and employment for local people, seconded Cllr Scobie – unanimously agreed

14/03539/FUL-3 Pound Close – Garage conversion to a flat – Cllr Vial proposed that STC make no representation, seconded Cllr Cooper – **unanimously agreed** 

14/03397/FUL – 14 the Driftway – Install window to external wall – Cllr Scobie proposed that STC make no representation, seconded Cllr Vial – **unanimously agreed** 

14/03572/FUL – 68 Hawthorn Way – first floor side extension over the garage – a nearby neighbour was invited to explain his objection to this application, following discussion Cllr Vial proposed objection to this plan on following grounds: overbearing to neighbouring property; SDC guidelines on separation distances and the 45/25 rule for assessing privacy and visual impact, seconded Cllr Scobie – **unanimously agreed** 14/03612/TREE – Redwood Park Open Space, London Road – G1 reduce fir tree by 25% & lift crown - Cllr Saunders proposed that STC make no representation, seconded Cllr F Ivens – **unanimously agreed** 15/00036/TREE – Redwood Park Open Space, London Road – G1 remove 3 Leylandii – Cllr A Ivens proposed that STC make no representation, seconded Cllr Henderson – **unanimously agreed** 15/00021/FUL – 32 Furze Hill Road – extensions to side and rear - Cllr Scobie proposed that STC make no representation, seconded Cllr Vial – **unanimously agreed**
