NEW PLANNING APPLICATIONS

22/00235/FUL - 6 Callaways Road

Proposed two storey extension to form larger garage and bedroom.

Objection – proposed extension is in front of the building line. Committee disappointed in the lack of proposals for climate change.

22/00246/FUL - 37 Station Road

Erection of double storey first floor extension and single storey rear extension with zinc finish.

22/00209/FUL - 36 Donnington Road

Erection of a two storey rear extension to accommodate a ground floor playroom and dining room and upstairs a new bedroom and a bathroom extension.

Variation of condition 2 (approved plans) of 20/02912/VARY dated 16.06.2021 to allow plot 8 reconfiguration (re-location of the external chimney breast, extension of right side wall to line up with the rear of the garage, fenestration alterations) Original description - Vary condition 2 (approved plans) of planning permission 17/02741/FUL (relating to demolition of existing outbuildings. Erection of 18 dwellings (including 6 affordable and 3 local market homes) construction of access road, formation of attenuation pond, provision of open space and landscaping, erection of garage to serve 'Ridgeway' and all other associated works) to allow for minor changes to the approved plot, site layout plan and materials.
