6.6 OTHER PLANNING/INFRASTRUCTURE MATTERS

S106 in relation to Chapel View – update from Cllr Dinnie No spec from Orbit submitted. A path has been built but the open space area can't yet be completed. Planning Officer at SDC has referred the matter to Planning Enforcement. It was noted that a similar development elsewhere in Shipston offered 14 pieces of play equipment on their area, whereas Orbit are offering only 2 pieces (to Angela's Meadow). Cllr Tesh to circulate an example of play equipment on a development in a nearby county
