### 6.5.1 • Housing Needs Survey

Discussion on the presentations given by 3 companies offering their services. Updated costs requested from each of them for recommendation to council with a view to surveys going out to the public after Christmas

## 6.5.2 • Local Green Spaces/future house building

Cllr Dinnie drew the committee's attention to expected requirements from Government for more house building and that South of Stratford will likely be the area considered. The Neighbourhood plan may not protect Shipston and we already lack open space within the town. Cllr Dinnie suggests specifically protecting the land either side of the Hanson Track. Phil Sykes noted that Shipston needs land equivalent to 7 football fields to address the shortfall of open space set out in the Core Strategy, but there is none within the parish.

### Appendix to planning Committee meeting minutes 28th September 2020

Proposed wording of STC Objection

### Application 20/02368/OUT: 29 London Road, Shipston-on-Stour

Shipston Town Council objects to the proposed outline application for the demolition of the existing bungalow and the erection of 4 two-storey houses for the following reasons:

- Shipston-on-Stour has already exceeded its housing allocation in the current Local Plan so questions the need for additional housing as those already being built are not being sold.
- The proposed density of development is considered too high for the location and will be overbearing for the adjacent properties and the sports facilities.
- The loss of trees
- The adverse impact from the proposed significantly increased area of hardened surfaces (roofs/paved areas) on the site and the resultant surface water run-off will have on the existing drainage in London Road. There are existing problems with surface water drainage in London Road and downstream towards the outfall into the River Stour with surcharging of the existing system causing flooding which the proposed additional hardened surfaces will exacerbate. If the development is permitted the Town Council request a condition is imposed requiring the developer to attenuate within the site any surface water discharge from the development into the existing public sewers.
