9 COMMUNITY GROUP PRESENTATIONS

Presentations were heard from:

• Fay Ivens – Shipston Rotary

Thanked Council for their work over the past year. Provided a brief report on events over the past year. Joining up with Stour Valley Lions for the Victorian Evening. Multiple fundraising events throughout the year and events that have been put on for the community. Tour De Shipston, Trip to Weston Super Mare, Easter Bonnet Competition, Sunflower Competition, Cuckoo in the Nest, Mock Interviews held at the High School, Memory Lane Singing Group, High School kitchen equipment etc.

George Kelly – Shipston Proms

Provided a brief report of Shipston Proms. A 2 week event held in Shipston and surrounding villages starting with the Launch event will be held at the Townsend Hall on 21st June – The Drop Outs. The Proms have been going for 25 years. Music events from different genres, folk, opera, jazz, blues, choral, rock, pop. Big event up at the hub this year "Ibiza on Stour" with headlining DJ Dave Pearce, a famous Radio 1 DJ. The Last Night of the Proms is a free event. The whole Proms event takes £25,000 to £30,000 to put on the event. 90% of the funds are raised by sponsors, donations and collection buckets, raffle tickets. Wants to thank the Council for the Grant that has just been donated.

10 ITEMS OF GENERAL INTEREST FROM LOCAL RESIDENTS

Resident of Nason Way

Wanted to bring up the matter of roads and pavements on the new estates not being completed. Residents have aired concerns with the site manager and developers, but feel they haven't had a satisfactory response. Asked if there was anything that the Council could do to help. Cllr Dinnie encouraged that the residents concerned set up a residents association, providing a strong voice for all. Then to contact printner construction, the developers of the site. Cllr Tesh suggested contacting Stratford District Council as they are the planning authority to see if they could get Planning Enforcement involved.

Resident of Shipston on Stour

Raised concerns about a planning application that was put through in December, for the Old Power House on the Campden road. Change of use, from car hire, to pizza parlour. Wanted to know why this has not been decided yet and where the application is with regards to decision making. Cllr Tesh advised that The Town Council are consultees and the Planning Authority lies with Stratford District Council. Residents concerned that works have already been carried out, with installation of a vent, windows and access. It was advised that contact be made to Stratford District Council to involve the Planning Enforcement team to look into this.

Resident of Shipston on Stour Wanted an update of a meeting that took place with the Mayor of Bishops Castle, Josh Dickens, who has been successful in their application to get 16 inpatient beds in their local Cllr Dinnie reported on the meeting. Listened to how they did it and is now looking at ways to set up the next step to aid with the application of inpatient beds at the Ellen Badger Hospital. A committee was formed outside of the Town Council, representatives of the community, The Town Council of Bishops Castle endorsed this, but it was separate from The Town Council itself.
